A LAW TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND COMPOSITION OF TRANSITION COMMITTEES TO ADMINISTER LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL IN EKITI STATE PENDING ELECTIONS.

Commencement []

Enacted by the Ekiti State House of Assembly as follows:

Amendment of Local Government Transition Committee Law. (Cap L14 of 2010, Laws of Ekiti State) 1. The provisions of the Local Government Transition Committee Law, CAP L14, Laws of Ekiti State (in this Law referred to as “the Principal Law”) is amended as set out in this Law.

Composition.

Insertion of a new proviso as Subsection (2) in Section 2. 2. New provision as subsection (2) is hereby inserted in Section 2 to now read as follows:
(2) The Caretaker- Chairmen and the representative of each Ward in the Local Government Council by whatever name so called shall perform the duties and responsibilities assigned to elected Chairmen and Councilors in the Local Government Administration (Amendment) Law pending the conduct of Local Government election.

Approval by the House of Assembly.

Insertion of new provisions as Subsections (2) - (4) in Section 3. 3. New provisions as subsections (2) to (4) are hereby inserted in Section 3 to now read as follows:
(1) The appointment of the members of the Transition Committee shall be subject to the approval of the State House of Assembly.
(2) The approval of the State House of Assembly referred to above shall be given upon the presentation to it of a list of Nominees to be appointed as members of the said Transition Committee.

(3) The House of Assembly in approving the list supra shall ensure compliance with the provisions of Section 2 of this Law.

(4) The Executive Governor shall upon being granted the approval by the House to appoint Transition Committee shall proceed to swear them into Office within Seventy-two hours.

Tenure, duties and Remuneration.

*Amendment of
Section 4 of the
Principal Law.*

- 4.** Section 4 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by substituting the number “3” in line 1 with “6” to now read as follows:

Section 4: The tenure of the Transition Committee shall be 6 months in the first instance and shall be renewable only once. The duties and remuneration of the members of the Committee shall be as specified in their letter of appointment, subject to the approval of the State House of Assembly.
