WHAT IS BUDGET

A Budget is an estimate of what Government intends to generate as revenue (including its borrowing plans) and proposed expenditure within a period usually one year.

A Budget is a document which provides detailed narrative of how Government intends to spend its financial resources for the general well being of its people.

For accountability, Ekiti State Government is committed to engaging its people on how the State's fiscal resources are judiciously expended in line with the five (5) pillars of Government which are as follows:










GRANTS




