FOCUS OF THE 2025 BUDGET

The 2025 Appropriation Bill was signed into Law by His Excellency, the Governor, Mr 'Biodun Abayomi Oyebanji on Monday, December 30, 2024.

The fiscal document christened "Budget of Sustainable Impact" has a size of ₦375,790,077,618.15 with a recurrent-capital ratio of 51:49. The 2025 Budget focuses essentially on food security, wealth creation, basic education, primary health care infrastructural development and the completion of all on-going projects/programmes to enhance the actualization of the administration's policy of shared prosperity.

Also, the sum of ₦7,803,464,486.52 was earmarked for basic education programmes and projects, while the sum of ₦517,619,439.22 was earmarked for primary health care programmes and projects in the 2025 Budget. These programmes and projects align with the Ekiti State 30-Year Development Plan and the Six Pillars which are as follows:

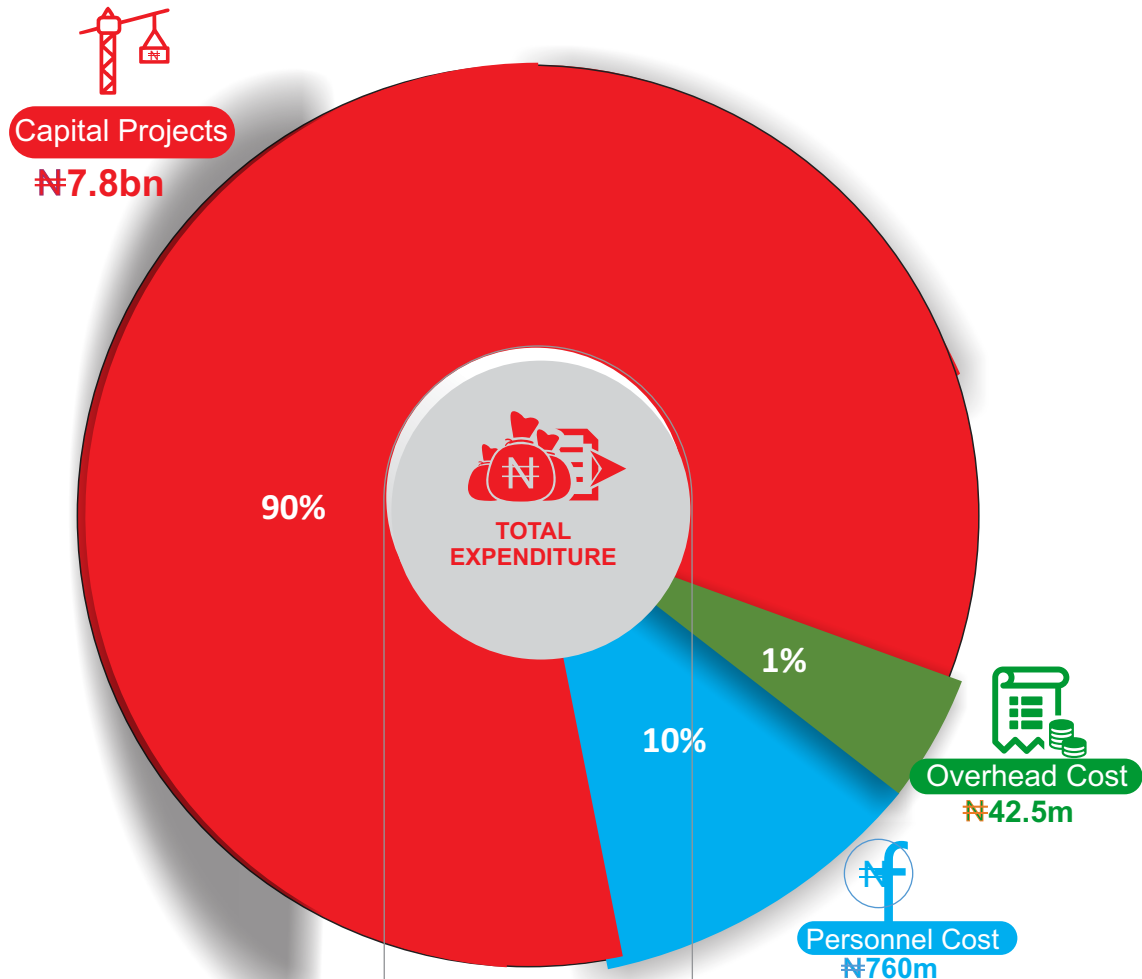

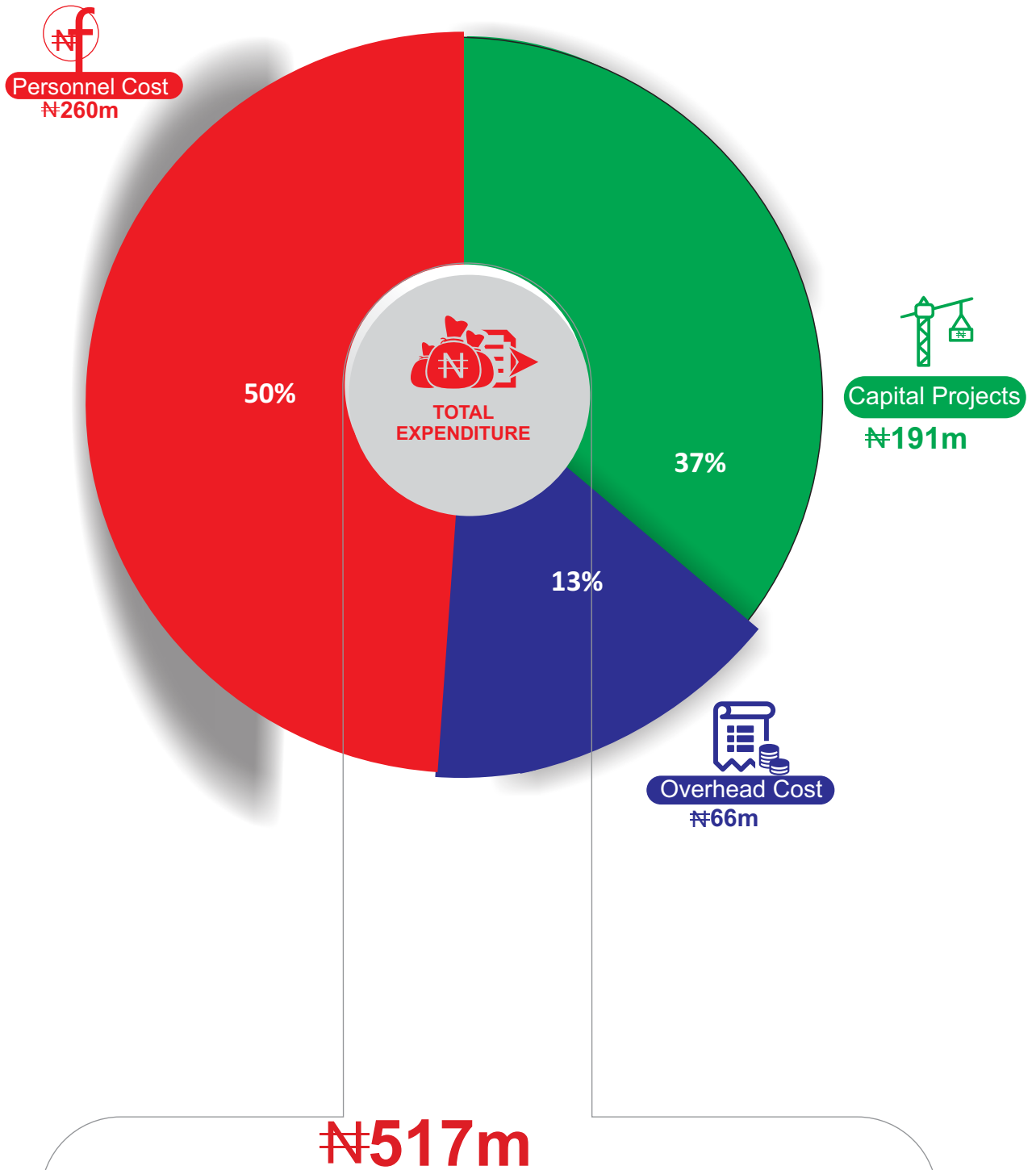

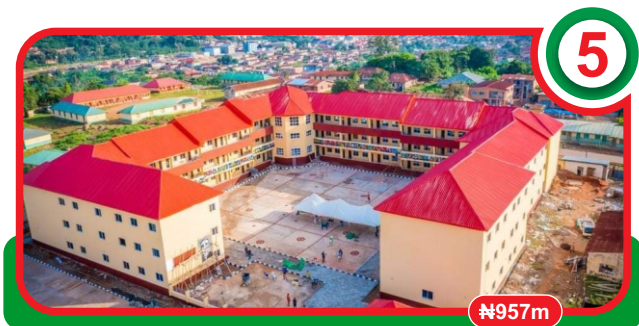
