


I hope this e-mail meets you well.

I write to respond to BudgIT Foundation preliminary findings on Q3 2025 analysis concerning Ekiti State Procurement Portal.

The Ekiti State Bureau of Public Procurement as part of the strategies to improve the service delivery key into e-procurement system operating e-registration, e-publishing and e-notification amongst other modules. The state since 2020 after the reenactment of the procurement law, the Bureau started with the launch of our BigFuT portal which provide the e-registration services as well as e-certification to MDAs of the state.

The Bureau also developed a home grown OCDS portal which support in the e-publishing of contracts on a real-time basis and still running as of now hosted on a strong domain. Also through SFTAS P for R program, we procured the services of European Dynamics to add more modules to the existing services provided. For the confirmation of the existence of this e-procurement portal services, these are the Uniform Resource Locator (url): **portal.bpp.ekitistate.gov.ng**, **ocdsportal.azurewebsites.net**. These urls are available to the public and known to the external public especially the citizens of the state.
