## **A Brief History of Ekiti State**

Ekiti State is one of the 36 States in the Federal Republic of Nigeria and one of the six Yoruba-speaking States of the southwest region of Nigeria. Ekiti is unique as the most homogenous State in Nigeria with all its lands and communities being the ancestral, traditional, and customary home of the Ekiti people of the 11th century Oduduwa Dynasty. The State was created on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1996 by the then military government of Late Gen. Sanni Abacha. It is made up of 16 Local Government Areas and additional 22 LCDAs created in 2021. The state capital is the ancient city of Ado Ekiti, under the traditional rulership of the Ewi of Ado-Ekiti. The 2024 projected population of Ekiti State is 4,351,326. It is a known fact that the people of Ekiti love education and pursuit of knowledge. The official slogan of Ekiti state was formerly "Fountain of Knowledge" and now "Land of Honour, Ile Iyi, Ile Eye".

## **Motivations for Preparing the MTSS Document**


