## **2.0 Introduction of Dignitaries to the High Table.**

The moderator of the day Miss Yewande then invited to the high table, dignitaries that graced the occasion they include; the representative of Ewi of Ado Ekiti, the DPO of the Okesha Police station, the Iya Oloja of Ado Ekiti, the formal Chairman of Ado West LCDA, The HLA of Ado West LCDA amongst others.

## **3.0 Chairman's Welcome Remarks**

The Chairman of the Local Council, Hon Bolu Aladesanmi welcomed the representatives of various communities under the LCDA to the meeting. He lauded them for their support and maintaining peace in their various domains.

He explained that the meeting was called to garner their inputs for the year 2026 appropriation bill. The Chairman also stated that his administration has recorded 95% success rate in the Budget

implementation in the outgoing year. He maintained that most requests by the communities in the year 2025 budgets have been attended to ranging from Grading of roads, Sinking of Boreholes, and Construction of Culverts amongst other projects. He urged the community leaders to continue to support and cooperate with his administration.

#### **4.0 Community Engagement**

The podium was then thrown open for representatives of different areas of the LCDA to make their requests, observation and remarks. The first person was the Chairman of the Araromi Community, Mr Olabode Badmus who thanked the present administration for their selflessness towards the development of the LCDA. He then pleaded with the administration to look into the issue of a standard Health care center, solar powered street lights and motorable roads which the community lacked. He said provision of these amenities would be of great benefit to his community.

The next person to mount the podium was the Iya Oloja of the Okesha market who praised the Aladesanmi's administration for the obvious development it had brought about to the LCDA. She then went further to plead with the management of the LCDA to make provisions of standard sanitary facilities in and within the market area which include; Toilets, waste bins, kilns and good drainage facilities. She hoped that these requests should be treated with topmost urgency.

Another Community representative, the Chairman of Dongo Community, Mr Ajewole Jachim Busayo was next to speak. He also thanked the administration of Hon Aladesanmi and the LCDA for their commitment to the development of the LCDA and pledged his community's continued support to the administration. He went further by soliciting for a new transformer in his community as the present transformer was old and had developed faults. He prayed that the request be treated with urgency as the community was continuously thrown into darkness because of this problem.

Other participants were also given the opportunity come out and give their opinion, suggestions and requests. They include, representative from MaryLand, Ayeyemi, Ore Ofe, Olanrewaju and Penny Wise.

### **5.0 AOB**

The HLA of the LCDA Mrs Funmilayo Adeyeye then came up to address those present at the meeting appealing to them for their continued support for the Ekiti State Government led by his Excellency, Governor Biodun Abayomi. She said that none of the projects would have been possible without his support and cooperation. In her remarks the Director of Budget Planning Research and Statistics (BPR&S) Mrs Fayigbe Kehinde thanked the various community representatives for their continued support and urged them to sustain their loyalty to the BAO led administration.

### **6.0 Adjournment**

In the absence of further deliberations, the motion for the adjournment was moved by the Director of Procurement, Mrs C.Y Afolayan and was seconded by the Director of Works, Builder Titilayo Ajila.
