- 3.1.8 Since the Memorandum on State Action on Business Enabling Reforms (SABER) was desirable, Council:
 - noted the readiness of Ekiti State to continue its participation in the World Bank State Action on Business Enabling Reforms (SABER) programme in compliance with its requirements;
 - ii. noted the criterion to be met in the current year under Disbursement Link Indicator (DLI 3) (Development of an Effective Public Private Partnership Framework);
 - iii. noted that the criterion was the development and publication of Project Facilitation Fund (PFF) documents;
 - iv. noted that the documents were in three (3) parts as follows:
 - a. Ekiti State Infrastructure and Investment Facilitation Fund Regulation;
 - Ekiti State Project Facilitation Fund (PFF) Business Plan and Financial Plan; and
 - Ekiti State Project Facilitation Fund (PFF) Governance and Operational Manual.

- v. noted that the Ekiti Wealth Fund Law, 2023 was considered as the legal instrument for the development of the PFF documents;
- vi. noted that all the three (3) documents were prepared with technical support from the NGF via series of virtual clarity and review sessions;
- vii. noted that the documents were ready for implementation in Ekiti State;
- vill. noted that the online publication of all the three (3) PFF documents was one of the eligibility criteria for the DLI 3;
- ix. noted that the deadline for publication of the PFF documents was 31st of December 2025;
- note that the PFF documents had to be presented to the State Executive Council prior to its publication online;
- xi. noted that His Excellency, the Governor had approved the presentation of the PFF documents to the State Executive Council; and
- xii. approved the three (3) aforementioned Project Facilitation Fund (PFF) documents for implementation.
