REGULATORY PROCESS FOR OBTAINING RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT IN EKITI STATE

Pursuant to Ekiti State Right of Way Regulation, 2023, all service providers seeking to lay broadband infrastructure including Optic fibre in Ekiti State can apply for a Right of Way permit through the following process:

<p>Issuance of Demand Notice and Submission of Evidence of Payment of Right of Way Fees.</p> <p>After a successful site inspection, the applicant is issued a Demand Notice for the payment of the Right of Way fees</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Pay the applicable amount stated on the Demand Notice using any of the following payment channels: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Any commercial bank in the State b. Registered Ekiti State Internal Revenue Agents outlet c. Remita d. Ekiti Revenue Autonomous System (ERAS) 2. Submit a copy of the receipt as evidence/proof of payment of the Right of Way fee to the Office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development <p>Confirmation of Application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Upon submission of evidence of payment, the applicant will be notified within 2 days of successful application and can visit the Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development to collect approval for commencement of work on-site. ii. Where an applicant has not been notified of a successful application within the 2 days, the applicant should please contact the Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development located at Phase V, State Secretariat Complex, Ado-Ekiti, Ekiti state. 	<p>Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development</p>	<p>2 Days</p>	<p>This is calculated based on the coverage area of the Optic fibre cable by the ₦145per linear meter stipulated in the Executive Order No. 007 of 2020 and the Ekiti State Right of Way Regulation, 2023</p> <p>TYPICAL EXAMPLE: An optic fibre cable with a total length of 345 linear meters is to be laid</p> <p>Right of Way = 345 x ₦145 = ₦50,025</p> <p>NB: a charge of ₦700,000.00 per site for BTS (Base Transceiver Station) is imperative as stated in the Ekiti State Right of Way Regulation, 2023.</p>

<p>Approval to Commence Work</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Upon confirmation of application, Applicants are notified via text or call within 5-10 days for approval to commence work on site.ii. The site is monitored to ensure compliance and non-damage of public infrastructure. Where there is damage to any public infrastructure/private property at the course of work on-site, the applicant is made to repair it. This is in line with Ekiti State Telecommunication Regulation 2023	Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development	10 Days	

STEP 5

Collection of Certificate of Completion i. Upon successful completion of work on-site, the applicant must submit a Completion Notice to the Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development. ii. A final site inspection is conducted by the Ministry of Physical Planning and Urban Development located at Phase V, State Secretariat Complex, Ado-Ekiti, Ekiti state and the applicant is issued a Certificate of Completion within 21 days upon successful clearance.
