APPLICATION PROCESS AND GUIDELINES FOR OBTAINING BUILDING PERMIT IN EKITI STATE

In pursuant of Ekiti State Urban and Regional and Development Law No. 3 of 2011, section 28, subsection 1-6 and Ekiti State Building Regulations, 2017, Section 2, Subsection 1-4 all individuals and organizations seeking to develop their land in Ekiti State can apply for a development (building) permit through the following process:
